



### SATs

Northbourne Park School has entered pupils for the Key Stage 2 SATs for many years and with above average results, but decided to withdraw from the process this year, following the recent concerns about marking and other aspects of the procedure.

### Kent Test

Each year some pupils in Year 6 take the Kent Test, which is a highly selective test for entry to local grammar schools. The number of candidates varies according to parental wishes. Over the past 3 years results have been as follows:

2007 – Kent Test - 2 candidates, 2 passed.

2008 – Kent Test - 9 candidates, 6 passed.

2009 – Kent Test and Dover Grammar Test – 4 candidates, 3 passed.

### Common Entrance

The majority of our pupils stay on for Years 7 and 8 to prepare for Common Entrance and/or Scholarship exams for entry to Senior Schools.

We have a 100% success rate for pupils gaining places at their first choice schools. Pupils move on to a wide range of schools including King's Canterbury, St. Edmund's Canterbury, Kent College, Benenden, Tonbridge, Sevenoaks, Eton, Woldingham, The Leys, St. Lawrence College and others.

### Scholarships

We also have a commendable record of Scholarship attainment which is recorded on display boards in the school Dining Room. Results over the past 3 years are as follows:
