



Summer Immersion Programme: June 2027

A month of **language, learning, and cultural immersion** in a caring English boarding school environment.

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Children join either our UK or French curriculum classes for a five- to seven-week programme. All participants take part in the school's regular lessons and activities, enjoying a truly immersive experience at the end of Northbourne Park School's academic year. Children return home with enhanced English language skills, new friendships, and the confidence and personal growth that come from boarding life.

Entry Points

The Summer Immersion Programme is open to children aged **8 and above**. Participants may join either our **UK curriculum** (Year 3 — Year 8) or our **French system** (CM2/6e, 5e, or 4e — up to age 14).*

- **UK curriculum classes** are taught entirely in English and are suitable only for children with a strong level of English.
- **French system classes** are ideal for French-speaking children with beginner-level English, combining French curriculum lessons with subjects such as Sport, Music, and Drama taught in English, alongside the UK curriculum pupils.

All children receive intensive English tuition during the first week of the course. Regular English lessons form part of the ongoing curriculum, and English is encouraged throughout the school day.

There are no compulsory excursions, and children may remain at school for the full duration of both the Summer Immersion Programme and the Summer Camp.

A "Long Weekend" — an opportunity for children to travel home or for parents to visit — is scheduled for the weekend beginning **Friday 18 June**. Transport to and from London St Pancras International for Eurostar services can be arranged on for an additional fee.

Summer Camp 2027

Children may remain at Northbourne Park for an additional two weeks, joining the Summer Camp, which combines English language lessons, excursions, and outdoor activities with English-speaking pupils from our day camps.

<i>(Week 6 Summer Camp):</i> Sunday 4 July – Sunday 11 July	English lessons, excursions, and activities with the English-speaking day camp.
<i>(Week 7 Summer Camp):</i> Monday 12 July – Sunday 18 July

Admissions & Fees

All Summer Immersion pupils will have either a video call with the Head Teacher, accompanied by their parents, or an in-person visit to the school. Following this, families are asked to pay a **non-refundable £120 registration fee** and a **£500 refundable deposit**, which is returned when the child leaves the school.

The Summer Immersion Programme is priced as follows:

English Years 3 – 5

Option A:	6 June – 2 July	£ 6,500 (inclusive)
Option B:	6 June – 18 July (including the Summer Camp)	£ 8,800 (inclusive)

English Years 6 – 8, French CM2/6e – 4e

Option A:	6 June – 2 July	£ 7,500 (inclusive)
Option B:	6 June – 18 July (including the Summer Camp)	£ 9,800 (inclusive)

The Summer Camp may also be booked as a separate, standalone experience.

All admissions paperwork and course fees must be completed and paid **in advance of the start date (31 May)**.
