



Summer Immersion Programme: June 2026

A month of **language, learning, and cultural immersion** in a caring English boarding school environment.

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Children join either our UK or French curriculum classes for a five- to seven-week programme. All participants take part in the school's regular lessons and activities, enjoying a truly immersive experience at the end of Northbourne Park School's academic year. Children return home with enhanced English language skills, new friendships, and the confidence and personal growth that come from boarding life.

Entry Points

The Summer Immersion Programme is open to children aged **10 and above**. Participants may join either our **UK curriculum** (Year 6 or Year 7 classes — up to age 13) or our **French system** (CM2/6e, 5e, or 4e — up to age 14). *

- **UK curriculum classes** are taught entirely in English and are suitable only for children with a strong level of English.
- **French system classes** are ideal for French-speaking children with beginner-level English, combining French curriculum lessons with subjects such as Sport, Music, and Drama taught in English, alongside the UK curriculum pupils.

All children receive intensive English tuition during the first week of the course. Regular English lessons form part of the ongoing curriculum, and English is encouraged throughout the school day.

2026 Dates

Arrival:	Sunday 31 May 2026
Start:	Monday 1 June 2026
Finish (Option A):	Friday 3 July 2026
Finish (Option B, including Summer Camp):	Sunday 19 July 2026

There are no compulsory excursions, and children may remain at school for the full duration of both the Summer Immersion Programme and the Summer Camp.

“Long Weekends” — opportunities for children to travel home or for parents to visit — are scheduled for the weekends beginning **Friday 12 June** and **Friday 26 June 2026**. Transport to London St Pancras International for Eurostar services can be arranged on **Friday 12 June** for an additional fee.

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Sunday 31 May	Arrival: Arrival, welcome, and settling-in activities.
<i>Week 1:</i> Monday 1 June – Friday 5 June	English Lessons: Immersion pupils spend the first week studying English in the mornings and taking part in activities with classmates in the afternoons.
<i>Week 2:</i> Monday 8 June – Friday 12 June	Trips Week: Children join their class for a week-long residential trip.
<i>Week 3:</i> Monday 15 June – 19 June:	School Immersion: Two weeks of lessons and activities with their class.
<i>Week 4:</i> Monday 22 June – 26 June	
<i>Week 5:</i> Monday 29 June – 3 July:	Farewell Week: Final week of term, with special activities and celebrations. Parents are warmly invited to attend Prize Giving & Speech Day on Friday 3 July .

Summer Camp 2026

Children may remain at Northbourne Park for an additional two weeks, joining the Summer Camp, which combines English language lessons, excursions, and outdoor activities with English-speaking pupils from our day camps.

<i>(Week 6 Summer Camp):</i> Sunday 5 July – Sunday 12 July	English lessons, excursions, and activities with the English-speaking day camp.
<i>(Week 7 Summer Camp):</i> Monday 13 July – Sunday 19 July

Admissions & Fees

All Summer Immersion pupils will have either a video call with the Head Teacher, accompanied by their parents, or an in-person visit to the school. Following this, families are asked to pay a **non-refundable £ 120 registration fee** and a **£ 500 refundable deposit**, which is returned when the child leaves the school.

The Summer Immersion Programme is priced as follows:

Option A:	31 May – 3 July	£ 6,500 (inclusive)
Option B:	31 May – 19 July (including the Summer Camp)	£ 8,800 (inclusive)

The Summer Camp may also be booked as a separate, standalone experience.

All admissions paperwork and course fees must be completed and paid **in advance of the start date (31 May)**.
