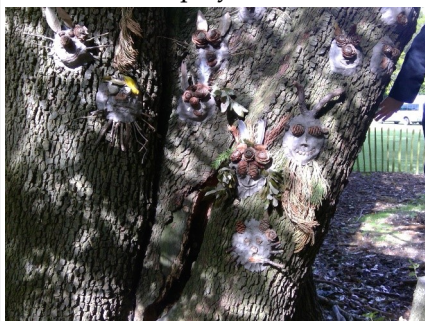


Message from the Headmaster
