6eme class have been studying neutralisation reaction. The products have a neutral pH of 7, green colour of the universal dye. Here are two successful scientists...



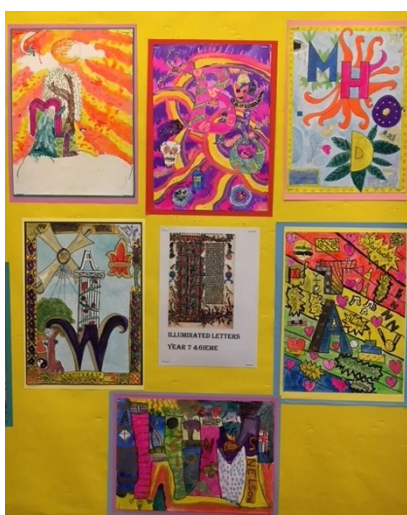
500 words
